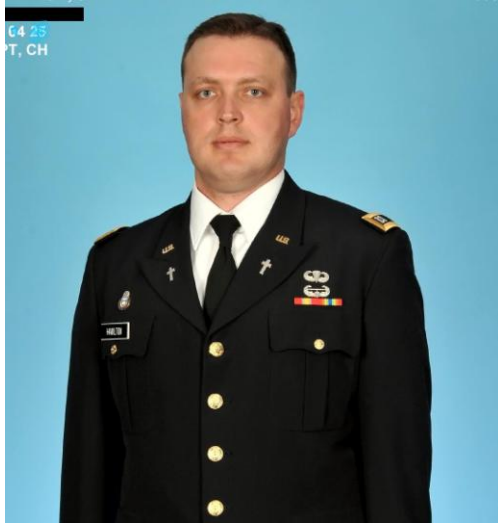


Chaplain (CPT) Seth Hamilton
