## CHAPLAIN, MAJOR DANIEL R. LLORENTE

Chaplain, Maj Daniel R. Llorente is the Deputy Wing Chaplain assigned to the 944<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing, Luke Air Force Base, A.Z. Chaplain Llorente is a Traditional Reserve Chaplain, providing spiritual care for the Luke AFB community and Geographically Separated Units located in Davis-Monthan AFB, Holloman AFB, and Seymour Johnson AFB. As the Deputy Wing Chaplain, he ministers to more than 2,100 Traditional Reservists, Civilians and Families assigned to the 944<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing. He leads three Chaplains and three Religious Affairs Airmen to ensure the free exercise of religion. His responsibilities include advising leadership on all spiritual, ethical and moral issues, and providing pastoral counseling and crisis intervention services.

Chaplain Llorente received his commission on Aug. 2010 as a Chaplain Candidate in the Air Force Reserve Chaplain Candidate Program. He was ordained at Tri-City Baptist Church in Chandler, Ariz. on Jan. 2014. He graduated from Seminary at International Baptist College and Seminary in Chandler, Ariz., completing his Masters in Divinity on May 2014. He reappointed as an Air Force Chaplain on Aug. 2014. As a Chaplain, he is endorsed by Foundations Baptist Fellowship International. As a civilian, he serves as an Associate Pastor at Tri-City Baptist Church ministering to Young Adults and Professionals. He is also full-time Senior Software Engineer with over 20 years of experience in multiple industries. He current employment is with Verra Mobility.
