CHAPLAIN, CAPTAIN JEFFREY M. RYBOLD

Captain Jeffrey Rybold is a Chaplain assigned to the 56th Fighter Wing, Luke Air Force Base, Arizona. He assists the

Wing Chaplain in advising and representing the 56th Fighter Wing commander on all aspects of the Chaplain Corps mission, while ensuring the protection of First Amendment, "Free exercise of religion." The wing supports national security objectives by training combat ready F-35 and F-16 pilots and maintainers, while providing support to more than 10,000 military and civilian personnel. Ch Rybold also assists in planning, coordinating and executing Chapel Community Programs.

Capt Rybold enlisted in the Air Force in March 2002 and completed Ground Radio Maintenance technical training. After 12 years of Active Duty service, he cross-trained into the Chaplain Assistant Air Force Specialty Code as an Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA), graduating technical training in June 2015. He graduated Summa Cum Laude from Liberty University with a Bachelor of Science in Christian Ministry in December 2017, continuing his education at Liberty's Rawling School of Divinity. During this time he received his commission in 2018 as a Second Lieutenant, Chaplain Candidate. In 2020 he received his Master of Divinity with an emphasis in Leadership. He then was reappointed as Chaplain to the 944th Fighter Wing, Luke AFB in January 2021 and further transitioned to Active Duty as Chaplin for the 56th Fighter Wing. He has 20 years of service in the USAF with roughly 12 years in Active Duty, 4 years as an IMA Reservist, and 3 years as a Chaplain



Candidate. In May 2018, he received his ordination and license as a Baptist minister. Prior to his commission, Captain was the IMA to the Noncommissioned Officer In Charge, Readiness and Training, 78th Air Base Wing, Robins AFB, Ga.
