CH (MAJ) Hamilton direct commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant on April 2nd, 2006. Upon graduating from Bob Jones Theological Seminary in 2011, CH Hamilton served in the Army Reserves as the Battalion Chaplain for the 391st Engineer Battalion, the 687th Combat Sustainment/Support Battalion, and the 432nd Civil Affairs Battalion. CH Hamilton also served as Pastor for Lakeland Baptist Church in Crandon, WI from 2011-2015. In February 2015, CH Hamilton accessioned to Active Duty, and served with the 92nd Engineer Battalion (C)(H), the 2-7th Infantry Battalion, and the 1st Psychological Operations Battalion (Airborne). He is currently assigned to 1st Special Forces Command, Fort Bragg, NC.

CH Hamilton's military education includes Chaplain Captain Career Course, Chaplain Basic Officer Leader Course, the USASOC Jumpmaster Course, the Basic Airborne Course, Air Assault School, and the USACAPOC(A) Religious Area Advisement Course. He graduated from Baptist College of Ministry with a B.A. in Pastoral Studies in 2005 and from Bob Jones Theological Seminary with his M. Div. in 2011.
