CHAPLAIN, MAJOR DANIEL R. LLORENTE

Chaplain, Maj Daniel R. Llorente is the Wing Chaplain assigned to the 944th Fighter Wing, Luke Air Force Base, A.Z. Chaplain Llorente is a Traditional Reserve Chaplain, providing spiritual care for the Luke AFB community and Geographically Separated Units located in Davis-Monthan AFB, Holloman AFB, and Seymour Johnson AFB. As the Wing Chaplain, he ministers to more than 2,100 Traditional Reservists, Civilians and Families assigned to the 944th Fighter Wing. He leads two Chaplains and three Religious Affairs Airmen to ensure the free exercise of religion. His responsibilities include advising leadership on all spiritual, ethical and moral issues, and providing pastoral counseling and crisis intervention services.

Chaplain Llorente received his commission on Aug. 2010 as a Chaplain Candidate in the Air Force Reserve Chaplain Candidate Program. He was ordained at Tri-City Baptist Church in Chandler, Ariz. on Jan. 2014. He graduated from Seminary at International Baptist College and Seminary in Chandler, Ariz., completing his Masters in Divinity on May 2014. He reappointed as an Air Force Chaplain on Aug. 2014. As a Chaplain, he is endorsed by Foundations Baptist Fellowship International. As a civilian, he serves as an assistant to the pastor at Grace Baptist Church, Scottsdale. He is also a full-time Data Solutions Engineering Manager with over 20 years of experience in Information Technology and Software Development. He current employment is with Axon.
